Niagara Health currently operates Douglas Memorial and will not provide ongoing funding once the new hospital is completed in Niagara Falls. In 2028 we will no longer have local access to the care that we have had since 1931.

When SOS began, we called on the community to ask if losing Douglas Memorial mattered. We held a referendum and over 10,000 people took the time to say "Yes". They wanted local access to care in Fort Erie and more than primary care, more than a health team; they wanted 24/7 care in Fort Erie.
